Course Description

This course will introduce the officer to the rules of breath alcohol analysis, using the **Intoxilyzer 9000 Series**. Student will learn the role of the breath test operator, the instrumentation used to analyze breath test samples according to Chapter 11D-8 Florida Administrative Code, how to obtain a proper breath test sample, the proper way to administer a breath test using the **Intoxilyzer 9000**, and how to testify regarding the breath test that was conducted through courtroom testimony.

Each student must also successfully demonstrate proficiency in administering a breath test and completing the associated paperwork, as well as pass a written examination.
