X. New Business

They will have a one hour dance lesson taught by a professional instructor and freestyle dancing afterward. There will be catered food and drinks from Publix for the students. They move to allocate \$337.59 for Bachata Moderna’s Spring social. (motion passed)**
- Common Thread Club activation - This is a club for LGBTQ and alternative students, and as well as just anyone. It’s a way to create a community, and they will talk about different subjects within the alternative culture and do a craft or game to go along with the meeting topic. The Common Thread club moves to become an active club on the Melbourne campus. (motion passed)**
- Museums Trip – On April 24th they will go to the Henry Morrison Flagler Museum and to the Norton Museum of Art, they are both in Palm Beach. The students will leave campus at 8:00am and return at 7:30pm the same day, and it’s open to all students on campus. These museums highlight Florida’s cultural and historical heritage and provides educational experiences connecting to art, history and STEM**

There will be a table outside of the student union with coloring pages, goodie bags, and flyers that detail the next day of their event. Smoothie afterward, and there is a 25 smoothie capacity. They move for Psychology Club to host the mental health outreach event and they move to allocate \$511.39 for the event. (motion passed)

They move for the Tabletop Gaming Club to host the Pokemon and Magic gathering card tournament and move to allocate \$720.03 for the tournament. (motion passed)**
